


· What were dinosaurs like?

Some dinosaurs were herbivores and ate only plants. Other dinosaurs, like Tyrannosaurus rex, were carnivores. They ate meat. They even ate other dinosaurs!

Most dinosaurs were very big. Some dinosaurs were more than 12 metres tall. That is as tall as six gorillas standing on top of one another! But not all dinosaurs were giants. There were also some smaller dinosaurs. For example, Compsognathus was only the size of a chicken. Dinosaurs gave birth to their young by laying eggs. There were a lot of different kinds of dinosaurs, from giant plant-eaters that walked on four legs to fast, scary meat-eaters that ran on two legs.
